Geijera parvifolia

(Wilga, Australian Willow, Sheep Bush)



Notes

Little pruning required, crown lifting.
Difficult to propagate with irregular availability of stock.

Origin	Dry inland areas in NSW, Qld, Vic & SA.
Habit	Slow to moderate growth rate. Small to medium sized evergreen broad-domed tree. Typical height: 7-12 metres. Typical width: 6-11 metres.
Description	Elegant, leathery, linear foliage. Ascending structural branches with pendulous smaller branches and foliage. White, strongly-scented flowers.
Tolerances	High drought and frost tolerance.
Site requirements:	Species adaptable to a wide range of climatic and soil conditions. Full sun to part shade.
